

FAQ - Free Oregon DEHUs

Is it really free? Yes, if you meet the qualifications!

What are the qualifications? You need to meet all of the following:

- OLCC licensed
- Portland Gas & Electric or Pacific Power utility
- Commercial electric meter
- Replacing old DEHUs
- Indoor cultivation

How long will this program last? This offer expires at the end of April, 2024. Enroll ASAP to participate.

Do I have to pay for the full price of the Dehumidification Units upfront? No. However, your project and business need to be pre-qualified and under contract with Seinergy first.

Do I need to buy my DEHUs from somewhere specifically? For \$0 down purchases, we can direct you to participating retail locations in Oregon. If you prefer to purchase the units upfront, use any vendor and we will issue you a reimbursement.

Do I have to destroy my old units? No, but they cannot remain in your facility.

Does it matter which units I am currently using, or their condition? They need to be in working order and actively in use. Their age, make, and model do not matter.

What if I already bought new DEHUs? If you have a 2024 invoice, talk to us and we may be able to get you a partial rebate.

What if I'm not ready to install new units for a few months, a year, etc? This program is not a good fit for you. By participating, you are contractually committing to installing your new equipment within 10 days of receipt.

What units qualify? Quest, Anden, and DryGair all qualify. Ask about other brands.

What if I'm growing in a greenhouse? You are not eligible for this program.

What if my facility is new or expanding? You qualify for a partial rebate, around 50% cash back.

Where does the rebate money come from? Your electric utility, PGE or Pacific Power.

Where does the utility get its money? Utility incentives are 100% ratepayer-funded. As a utility customer, you have paid into this fund.

Can I do it myself? Not if you want \$0 down.
